## If there is an **emergency**: We will **call 911**

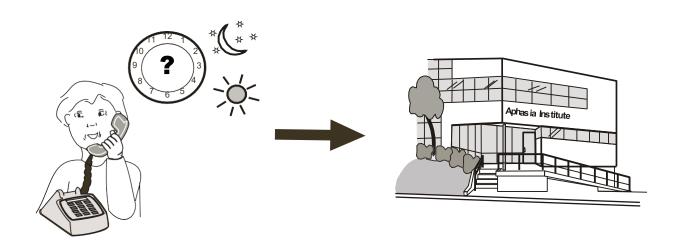

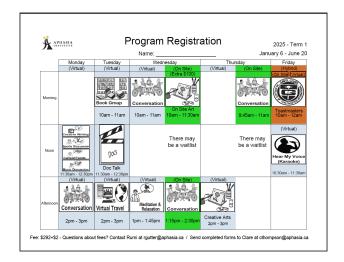
#### If you are away for more than 30 days



you may be discharged from programs

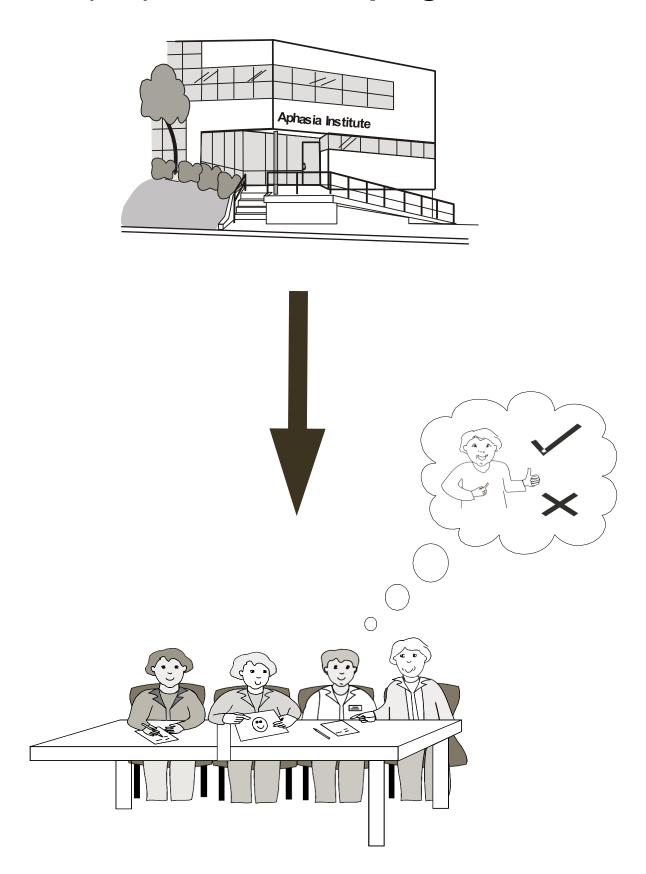

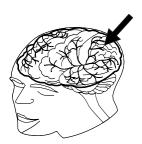

#### 1. If you are experiencing cognitive changes



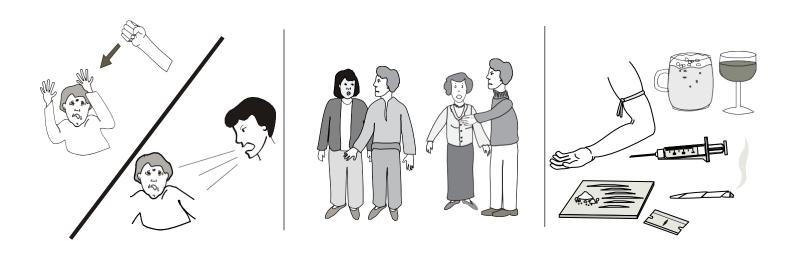
#### 2. If there is a **risk** to **yourself** or **others**:

safety

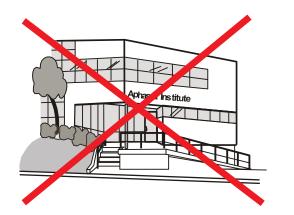

#### **Mechanical Restraints**



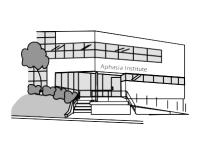
When **onsite**, if you **attend programs** with a **mechanical restraint** (e.g. lap belt)
